

Meredith Public Library Library Card Policy

The Meredith Public Library offers its collection, public computers and wireless access free of charge to all while in the library. Those who wish to apply for a library card may do so if they are age six and over, or in the first grade. Free cards will be given to:

- Residents and non-resident taxpayers to the Town of Meredith
- Students of the Inter-Lakes or Lakeland schools
- Employees of the Town of Meredith or the Meredith Public Library

Non-residents may receive a card for a fee of \$10.00 per year beginning on January 1, 2012. These cards will expire after one year and must be renewed and paid for annually.

All persons applying for a library card must present the following: Proof of residency such as a driver's license, tax bill, rental agreement or utility bill.
